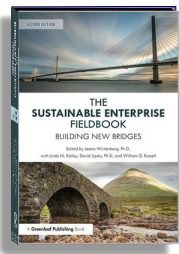


Chapter 1 Activity: Discussion Questions for Leadership

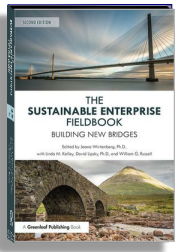
1. How do these models in Chapter 1 differ from the traditional “command and control” models still used in 2018?
